



Instructions for Fruit Bags for the homeless, served by Bread Drop

You will need to purchase small apples and small oranges (Clementines are fine, and bagged produce tends to be smaller than fruit available in the loose bins.)

You will also need sandwich-size ziplock bags. Please do not use larger bags, as they will be too big for folks to carry with them.

Each bag should be filled one apple and one orange. You can fill as many bags as you wish!

Return snack bags to the church on Monday, 1/17 between 11-1 pm.

Bread Drop partners with the E-meal program of Emmanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church in Souderton, PA to feed those who are unhoused and in need of food. The outreach program is now being supported by 16 or more churches, organizations, and other unaffiliated people of goodwill. Donations are averaging over 2,000 sandwiches per week, with almost 200,000 sandwiches, plus other items including snack bags and fruit, delivered to the homeless and outreach locations in several counties since the beginning of the pandemic.
