



Instructions for making the peanut butter & jelly sandwiches for Bread Drop and Face to Face:
please follow exactly as written!

- Do NOT make the sandwiches before Monday, so they will be fresh that day
- Make the sandwiches on soft, cheap WHITE bread, regular size.
- Spread bread with “gobs” of CREAMY peanut butter (NO crunchy) and GRAPE jelly. Put peanut butter on both sides of bread so the sandwiches won’t get soggy.
- Do NOT cut in half.
- Package each sandwich in a ziplock sandwich bag.
- Put all the bagged sandwiches back into the bread bag and close the bag with the plastic clip or a twist tie.
- Return bagged sandwiches to the church on Monday, 1/17 between 11-1 pm.

Note: For best hygiene protocol, we encourage anyone touching the sandwiches to wear plastic food gloves. We will make gloves available to you during our supply pick-up hours: 4-6 on Friday 1/14, or 10-12 on Saturday 1/15. If you do not have gloves and can’t pick them up, please be sure all hands are washed very well before making the sandwiches. Thank you for your consideration of other’s health!

Bread Drop partners with the E-meal program of Emmanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church in Souderton, PA to feed those who are unhoused and in need of food. The outreach program is now being supported by 16 or more churches, organizations, and other unaffiliated people of goodwill. Donations are averaging over 2,000 sandwiches per week, with almost 200,000 sandwiches, plus other items including snack bags, delivered to the homeless and outreach locations in several counties since the beginning of the pandemic.
