



Instructions for individual snack bags for the homeless, served by Bread Drop and the
Welcome Church
Please follow exactly as written!

You will need to purchase a variety of small, pre-packaged snacks - a mix of sugary and savory items:

- Raisins, fruit snacks, mini chocolates, chewy granola bars, cookies
- Potato chips (1 oz. bag), peanut butter crackers, cheese crackers, mini Slim Jims

You will also need **sandwich-sized*** ziplock bags. Each bag should be filled with 5 different items – preferably including 1 bag of potato chips and 1 box of raisins, as they are the most popular items. Remember to mix sweet and savory into each bag. ***Please do not use larger bags, as they will be too big for folks to carry with them.**

You can fill as many bags as you wish!

Return snack bags to the church on Monday, 1/17 between 11-1 pm.

Bread Drop partners with the E-meal program of Emmanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church in Souderton, PA to feed those who are unhoused and in need of food. The outreach program is now being supported by 16 or more churches, organizations, and other unaffiliated people of goodwill. Donations are averaging over 2,000 sandwiches per week, with almost 200,000 sandwiches, plus other items including snack bags, delivered to the homeless and outreach locations in several counties since the beginning of the pandemic.
